

Public Disclosure of CARES Student Grant Use

CARES Act's Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund
May 15, 2020

- 1. California Career Institute acknowledges that the institution has signed and returned to ED the certification agreement for HEERF funding and the California Career Institute intends to use, no less than 50% of its HEERF funding to provide emergency student grants.
- 2. The total amount of funds the institution has received from ED for emergency student grants is **\$105,561.00**
- 3. The total amount of emergency student grants distributed to students as of <u>5/15/2020</u> is \$35,187.00
- 4. The estimated total number of students eligible for student grants is **146.**
- 5. The total number of students who have received an emergency student grant as of the date of each disclosure **146**.
- 6. The institution's methodology: The institution will distribute the fund to all students equally. The distribution will continue on monthly basis over a period of three months.
- 7. Students were informed of the availability of the grant and process for distributing the fund via students' school emails. All students were instructed to update their current addresses with the school registrar.
